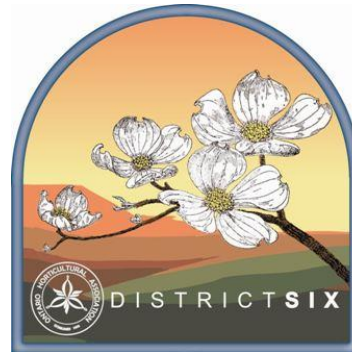
*****Reminder*****
