

Flower Show Guidelines June 2018:

- Exhibitors must be members of the Horticultural Society.
- All entries must include an entry tag showing the exhibitor's name, division and class information. The tag is either attached to the exhibit or ready to be placed beside it according to show schedule.
- In the Horticultural Section each exhibitor may enter up to three entries per class.
- All specimen blooms should have its own foliage attached except where stated by schedule.
- In Horticultural Classes: container grown plants must be owned and grown by exhibitor for at least three months prior to exhibiting. All specimen flowers/vegetables will be grown by the exhibitor.
- In the Design Section: plant material may be obtained from any source and design will be the work of exhibitor.
- Entries must be placed by 6:30pm on day of show - judging starts at 7pm
- The show committee has the authority to subdivide classes if there are a minimum of three entries per sub divided class.
- The Judge's decision is final
- Judging will be in accordance to "Ontario Judging and Exhibiting Standards " Exhibitors.

Point System for Awards:

2point per entry plus:

Specimen:

First Prize 7 points

Second Prize 5 points

Third Prize 4 points

Best in Show 10 points

Design:

First Prize 20 points

Second Prize 15 points

Third Prize 10 points

Best in Show 25 points

Points are accumulated over the year. Prize will be presented at November Meeting.
